



Trilobit Cup 2022 – rules

Trilobit Cup

The first year of the competition for the Trilobit Cup, organized by Judo v'ic než sport, z.s., in 2022, can be attended by judo clubs at the Králův Dvůr Tournament. The order of clubs in the competition is evaluated based on the results of pre-nominated competitors. The cup is lent to the winning club for the next year's Trilobit Cup, but no longer than one year after the lending. If the foreign club wins, the cup will not be handed over to the next year. The winner will take photos and the organizer will provide a label for the cup.

Nomination of competitors

The coach has the opportunity to nominate up to 5 of his competitors for each day of the competition. The nomination takes place after the competition has been drawn and before it starts.

Evaluation

The sum of points for all days of the competition is evaluated. The individual decision criteria are evaluated in the order below. It approaches the evaluation according to the following criterion if the order according to the current criterion is indecisive.

Evaluation criteria

1. Location

- 1st place = 7 points,
- 2nd place = 5 points ,
- 3rd place= 3 points,
- two 3rd places = 1 point.

2. Number of won matches

Number of won matches of all nominees for the club.

3. Sum of weight

Sum of the weights of all participants (the lower sum of the weights wins)

4. Sum of age

Sum of ages of all nominated competitors number of whole months from the date of birth to the date of the competition (the lower sum of ages wins), the values for the nominated competitors will be provided by the club coaches.
